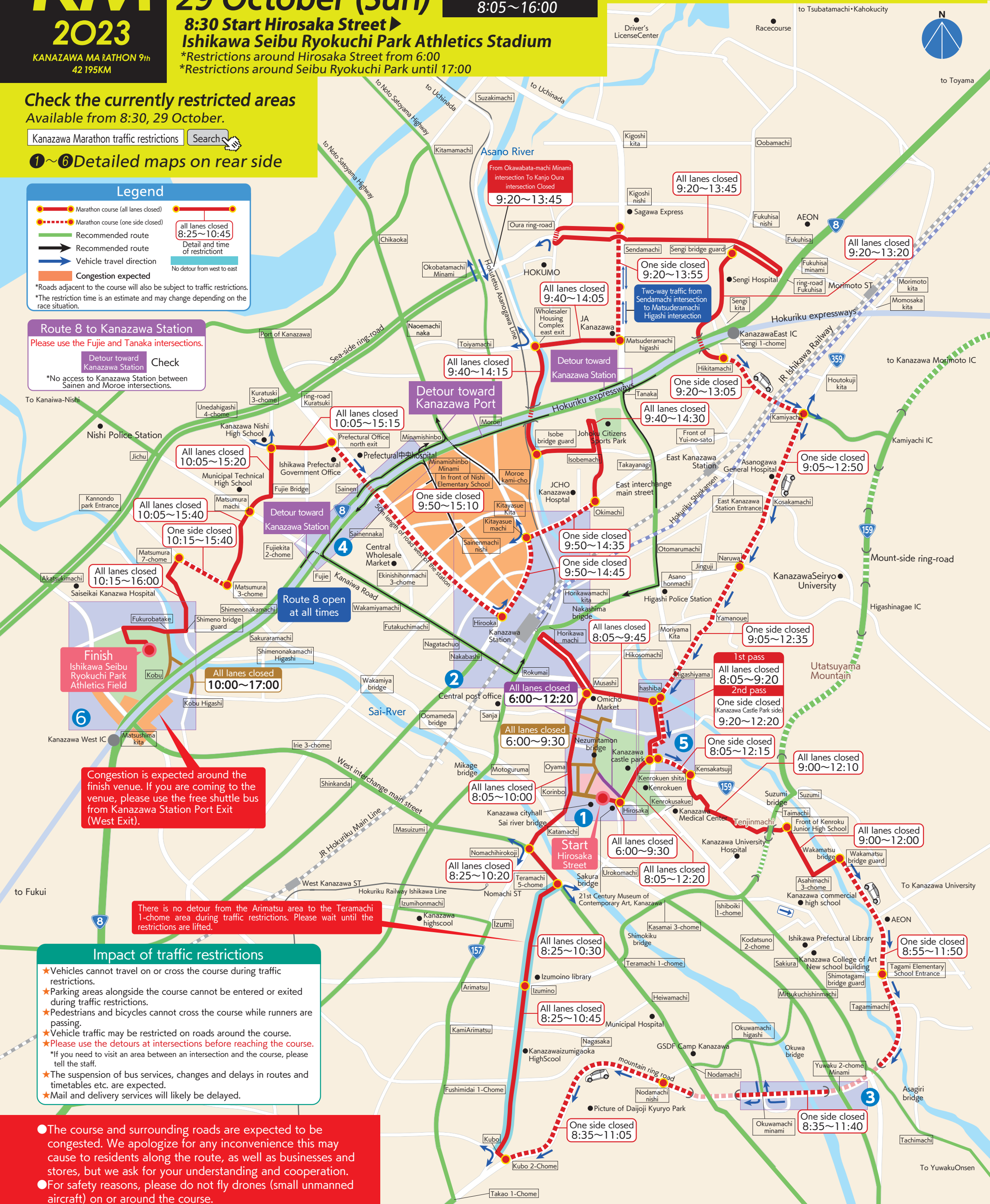
### Route 8 to Kanazawa Station

Congestion is expected around the finish venue. If you are coming to the venue, please use the free shuttle bus from Kanazawa Station Port Exit (West Exit).

There is no detour from the Arimatsu area to the Teramachi 1-chome area during traffic restrictions. Please wait until the restrictions are lifted.

### Impact of traffic restrictions

- ★ Vehicles cannot travel on or cross the course during traffic restrictions.
- ★ Parking areas alongside the course cannot be entered or exited during traffic restrictions.
- ★ Pedestrians and bicycles cannot cross the course while runners are passing.
- ★ Vehicle traffic may be restricted on roads around the course.
- ★ Please use the detours at intersections before reaching the course.  
\*If you need to visit an area between an intersection and the course, please tell the staff.
- ★ The suspension of bus services, changes and delays in routes and timetables etc. are expected.
- ★ Mail and delivery services will likely be delayed.

- The course and surrounding roads are expected to be congested. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause to residents along the route, as well as businesses and stores, but we ask for your understanding and cooperation.
- For safety reasons, please do not fly drones (small unmanned aircraft) on or around the course.
