For those considering living in municipal housing

About participation in the neighborhood association activities and paying the membership fee

- 1. Municipal housing is housing where residents manage common areas together with the neighborhood association members.
 - Management of flowerbeds and green spaces
 - Management of garbage collection sites
 - Payment of electricity bills for hallway lighting and elevators
 - Payment of water bills for shared water sources
 - Management of a meeting place, etc. (may differ depending on the neighborhood association)
- 2. Residents are requested to join the neighborhood association and participate in the activities (duty at a garbage collection site and duty as a group leader in turn, etc.) and pay the neighborhood association membership fee including the management fee for common areas, which is collected by a member of the neighborhood association.

If you are applying for municipal housing, please understand that you must participate in the neighborhood association activities and pay the neighborhood association membership fee.
